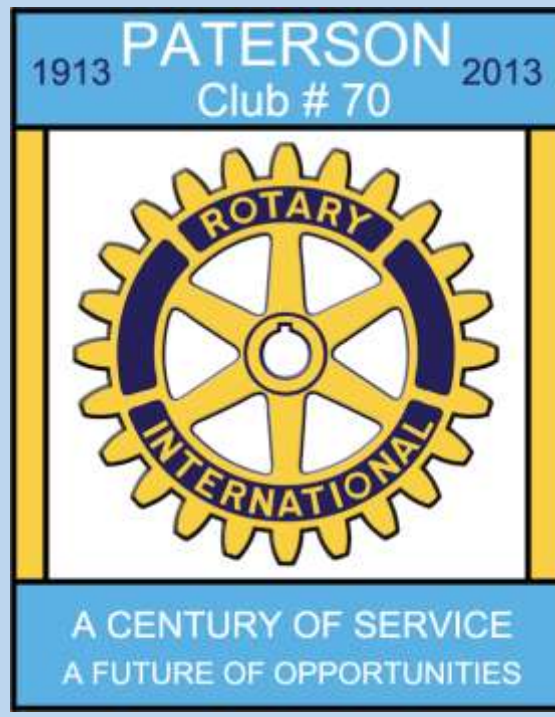

CUMAC

Mark Dinglasan, Executive Director

Mark moved back to New Jersey after 8 years in Chicago where he served as Executive Director for C.A.S.A. He was introduced to Rotary at a young age as his father was a dedicated Rotarian in the Phillipines.

He grew up with the “Service above self” mindset. He left law school to do missionary work, which began his “not for profit” career.

Mark came to work at CUMAC in June as the new executive director.

CUMAC serves 2,500 to 3,000 folks per month.

However, CUMAC is more than just a food pantry. Some of the programs are “Place of Promise” serving the homeless, The Thrift Shop Program and Community Closet which creates the opportunity of choice for recipients.

The goal, Mark tells us is to grow, do things better and change lives.

Ending hunger, he tells us, is not about feeding people as much as being about breaking the cycle.
