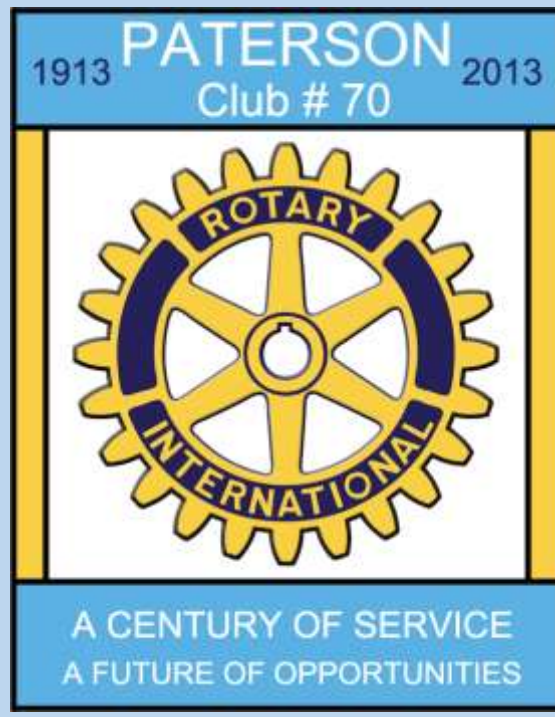

The Paterson Task Force

Roberta Farber, is the Events Planner for The Paterson Task Force which is a Community Action Agency and has agreed to speak to us today about the many services to the Paterson community that the Task Force provides.

She tells us that they currently have two **Women and Children's Shelters. Their mission is to make folks self-sufficient.**

Other services provided to the community include the following:

The Task Force has a **Nutrition program that feeds 600 children each weekend and has joined forces recently in this endeavor with the Paterson Rotary Club and our weekend "Food Boost Project" which feeds students in Public School # 28.**

Training programs to facilitate entry into the jobs market include CDL training, Computer skills, and wait staff training.

Goods and Services that pick up donated furniture and household goods.

"Employability Boutique" which provides suits of clothes for first time job interviews.

Financial Literacy Program that teaches budgeting and household finance.

Thank you Roberta for telling us more about your job, and the many services that The Paterson Task Force makes available to the community.
